

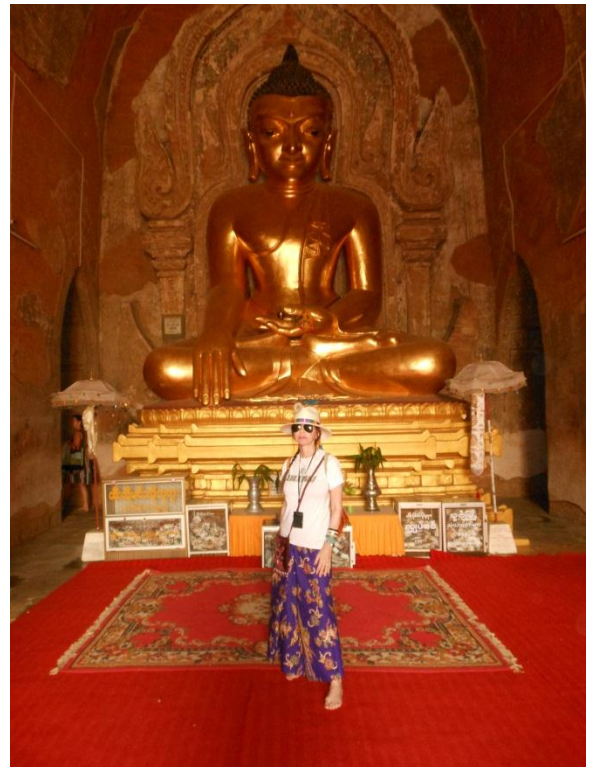

Yangon/Rangoon Shwedagon Pagoda



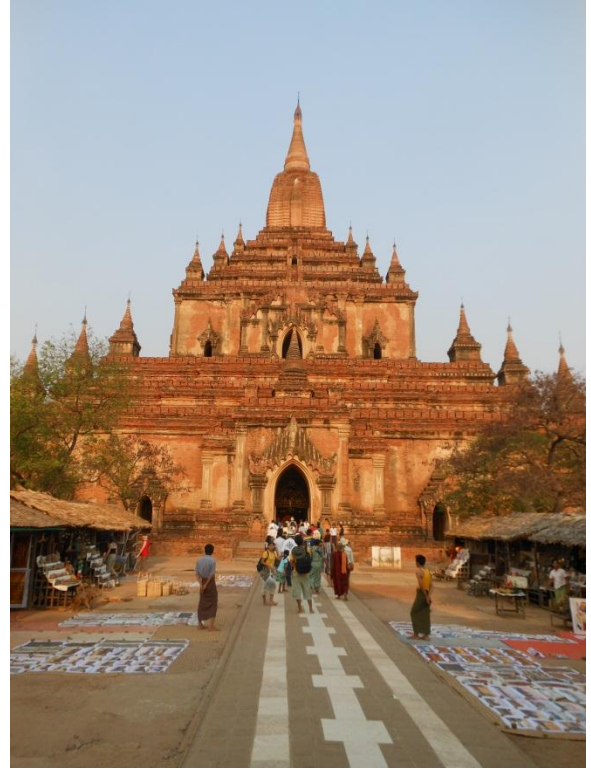
Bagan, land of temples and pagodas. There are over 4000 in the area. They date back centuries. Below left is Shweandaw Paya.

Note, though it was March, temperatures were over 100 F every day





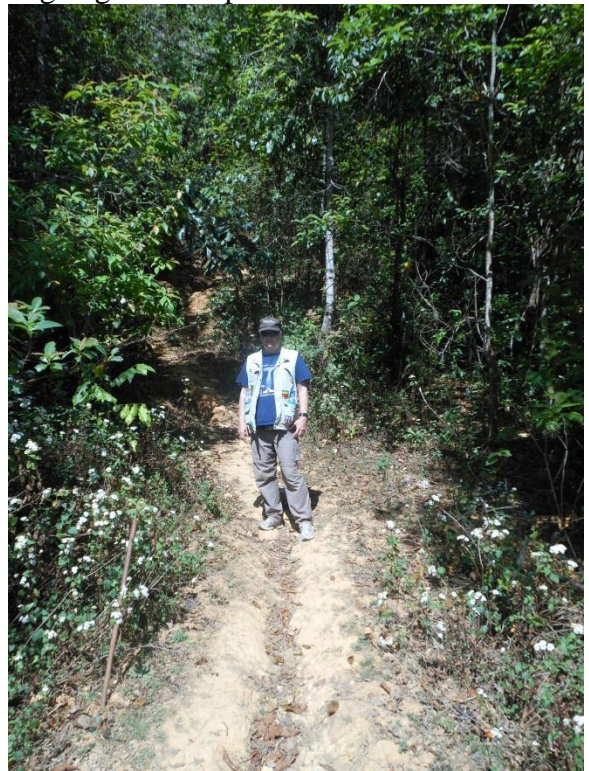

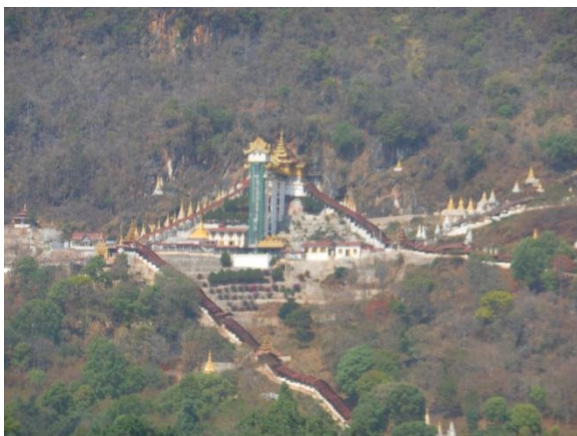
